Introduction

According to an *Industrial Training Needs* survey report (1997) prepared for the Northern Labour Market Information Clearinghouse by an independent consultant, about half the training needs of northern Alberta industries are satisfied in-house. The remaining half of training needs are satisfied through northern institutions (23%) and private sector training groups (24%). As well, industries are most likely to seek private trainers in the areas of driving and heavy equipment operation, environment, forestry, health and safety, oil and gas.

The 24% of training going to private sector trainers and some portion of the inhouse training currently not accessed through Clearinghouse partners, represents an opportunity for Clearinghouse partners to provide more training programs for northern industries.

In terms of course development and delivery, industry has made the following recommendations to Clearinghouse partners and to other post-secondary providers:

Course Development

- Increase the number, flexibility and cost effectiveness of courses that can be delivered to the industry site.
- While a good deal of industry training is developed and delivered in-house, there appears to be a definite industry need for post-secondary services. Therefore, current offerings should be continued, but monitored and improved.

Course Delivery

- Make more industry training available to students prior to their entering the workforce (i.e. co-op programs).
- Continue to offer courses locally to minimize travel expenses; bring more training to the community.
- Investigate and work toward providing on-site trades instruction at affordable cost.

- Where possible, increase the use of distance learning to delivered on-site training.
- Increase the availability of simplified (user friendly) tools to access training especially for remote and/or smaller communities.
- Market and deliver courses more effectively as corporate clients will go to whomever offers the best product at the best price.
- Compile an industry course list (i.e. cross-institutional calendar). Human resources directors do not have the time to look through several institutions' calendars.

This research report examines the "competition" in a number of areas of training. It reports a scan of public and private training opportunities available to northerners from Alberta trainers. Included is a review of the cost of private training provision and delivery modes of public and private training providers.

Approach

Information for this report was gathered through a review of the information gathered for the 1997 survey, print documents such as the *Peterson's Distance Learning* (1997) and *College Online* (1997). In addition, both the Yellow Pages and Internet were searched, specifically for private training providers. Also, telephone calls were made to private training providers to get a sense of sales revenue and number of northerners registered in private training.

Figure 1. indicates the scope of public and private training providers identified in the survey. For a more complete listing see Appendix A.

Survey of Public/Private Trainers

A scan of public and private training providers was conducted. While the following does not represent a definitive list, it provides an extensive overview of training providers in Alberta. Each PRIVATE training provider was contacted by telephone and asked to provide a range of pricing for their training. In addition, each provider was asked to estimate the amount of training they provided to the north (north of highway 16). Appendix A. is a contact list of private trainers.

Note Colleges and Universities identified as Private, may receive some public funding.

Observations

Driver training, business, computers and safety are areas that attract private trainers. The markets in these areas appear large and diverse. Business and computer training via the Internet are certainly growth areas.

While private training does not pose a large threat to the Clearinghouse partners, it would appear that private training is growing in the province, especially in its exploitation of niche markets.

Competition from private and public training providers using the Internet as a delivery mechanism is more difficult to assess. However, there is little question that almost any area of training can be offered and/or supported through the Internet. Examples provided in this study may serve to stimulate ideas and thinking around the potential for Clearinghouse partners to offer training programs. Such a move would broaden the target market for partners.

The cost to acquire training varies greatly. It would appear, though, that certain types of training have a high market value. Specialization may be the most astute strategy, especially if current partners have unique expertise that they can offer to others. There may also be an opportunity for Clearinghouse partners to include short-term training modules as part of their distance delivery strategy.
