

First Nations, Metis and Inuit Bursary (FNMI)

With an additional \$500,000 in new funding from Alberta Advanced Education, the Northern Alberta Development Council has expanded its student bursaries to provide financial support to indigenous post-secondary students.

The NADC FNMI Bursary is a return-of-service bursary. Funding is provided to recipients in exchange for their commitment to live and practice in their field of study within the NADC boundary for one year of full-time employment for each year of bursary support received.
